Since 18 January, part of the Fondation Le Corbusier's collections has been online. Discover almost 6,000 paintings, sculptures, drawings, papier collés, prints, enamels and tapestries by Le Corbusier. From June 2024, 8,000 photographs and 35,000 plans will gradually be added to our Base Corbu.

EXPOSITIONS



The Fondation Le Corbusier is presenting an exhibition of photographs from its archives at the Maison La Roche, showing the purist house in the late 1920s as it was occupied by its patron Raoul La Roche, an art collector and early supporter of Le Corbusier. A slide show also shows the interiors of the Maison Jeanneret, next door to the Maison La Roche, designed for Le Corbusier's brother and his family. The photographs on display are those commissioned by Le Corbusier from photographers Charles Gérard (1925) and Fred Boissonnas (1926).



CASSINA AND BOTTEGA VENETA PAY TRIBUTE TO LE CORBUSIER'S STOOL

In 1952, Le Corbusier created a stool for his Cabanon in Roquebrune-Cap-Martin. This emblematic piece has been reinterpreted as a tribute to Le Corbusier by Cassina and Bottega Veneta, in close collaboration with the Foundation. Developed with respect for Le Corbusier's original design, the stools were used as seating for Bottega Veneta's Winter 2024 fashion show, under the artistic direction of Matthieu Blazy. Reflecting the excellence of Cassina's joinery workshop and Bottega Veneta's long-standing commitment to innovative craftsmanship, the LC14 stools feature a carbonised wood technique, inspired by a traditional Japanese process. This method naturally protects the wood while revealing its unique patterns.

DES RACINES ET DES AILES — TERROIRS D'EXCELLENCE DANS LES VOSGES


This documentary focuses on the Duval factory. Rémi Duval, owner of the factory and son of its patron, tells the story of the only industrial building constructed by Le Corbusier. This report, which focuses on the Vosges region, also looks at the Notre-Dame-du-Haut chapel in Ronchamp and how it came into being.



PUBLICATIONS

LE CORBUSIER ON CAMERA : THE UNKNOWN FILM OF ERNEST WEISSMANN, VERONIQUE BOONE, ÉDITIONS BIRKHÄUSER

Between 1929 and 1933, Ernest Weissmann, an architect and collaborator at the studio, used his Pathé motocamera to capture the activities at 35 rue de Sèvres, immortalising the construction of the Villa Savoye and Le Corbusier's travels, as well as privileged moments in his life and friendships with Pierre Jeanneret, Jose Lluís Sert, Charlotte Perriand, Norman Rice, Kunio Maekawa and Sigfried Giedion, among others. In six chapters, the book presents never-before-seen images taken from these films and places them in their historical context.



NIVOLA — LE CORBUSIER : UNE AMITIÉ CRÉATRICE, ÉDITIONS DE L'ÉCLAT

This anthology of texts and correspondence looks back at the friendship and creative relationship between Le Corbusier and Costantino Nivola, from their meeting in 1946 in New York to Le Corbusier's death in 1965. The book also includes an interview with Maddalena Mameli by Ruth Nivola, Costantino's widow. This book is the last in a cycle of three books focusing on the life of Costantino Nivola: Vies et œuvres de Costantino Nivola and Mémoires d'Orani et autres écrits autobiographiques et autres écrits autobiographiques. The triptych on Costantino Nivola will be presented at the Librairie de la Cité de l'Architecture et du Patrimoine in Paris on Monday 25 March from 5pm to 7pm in the presence of the publishers, by prior arrangement.

This booklet presents photographs from the Antretemps exhibition held at Maison La Roche last September as part of Paris Design Week.




PARTNERSHIP

EUROPEAN COLLECTIVE HOUSING AWARD

HERITAGE

CLASSIFICATION OF THE VILLA BAIZEAU AS A PROTECTED MONUMENT

Built between 1928 and 1930, the villa is the only architectural project that Le Corbusier designed in Africa. Facing the sea on the Sainte-Monique hill in Carthage, the holiday villa was commissioned by Lucien Baizeau, who wanted a modern house adapted to the sun and winds of the Mediterranean. Following the exhibition Actualité de l'architecture simple - la Villa Baizeau Le Corbusier - Jeanneret, which runs in Tunis until 15 May, the Tunisian government decided to classify it as a protected monument.




VISIT OUR SITES
