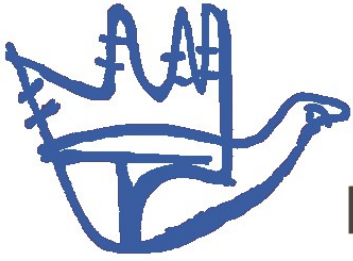


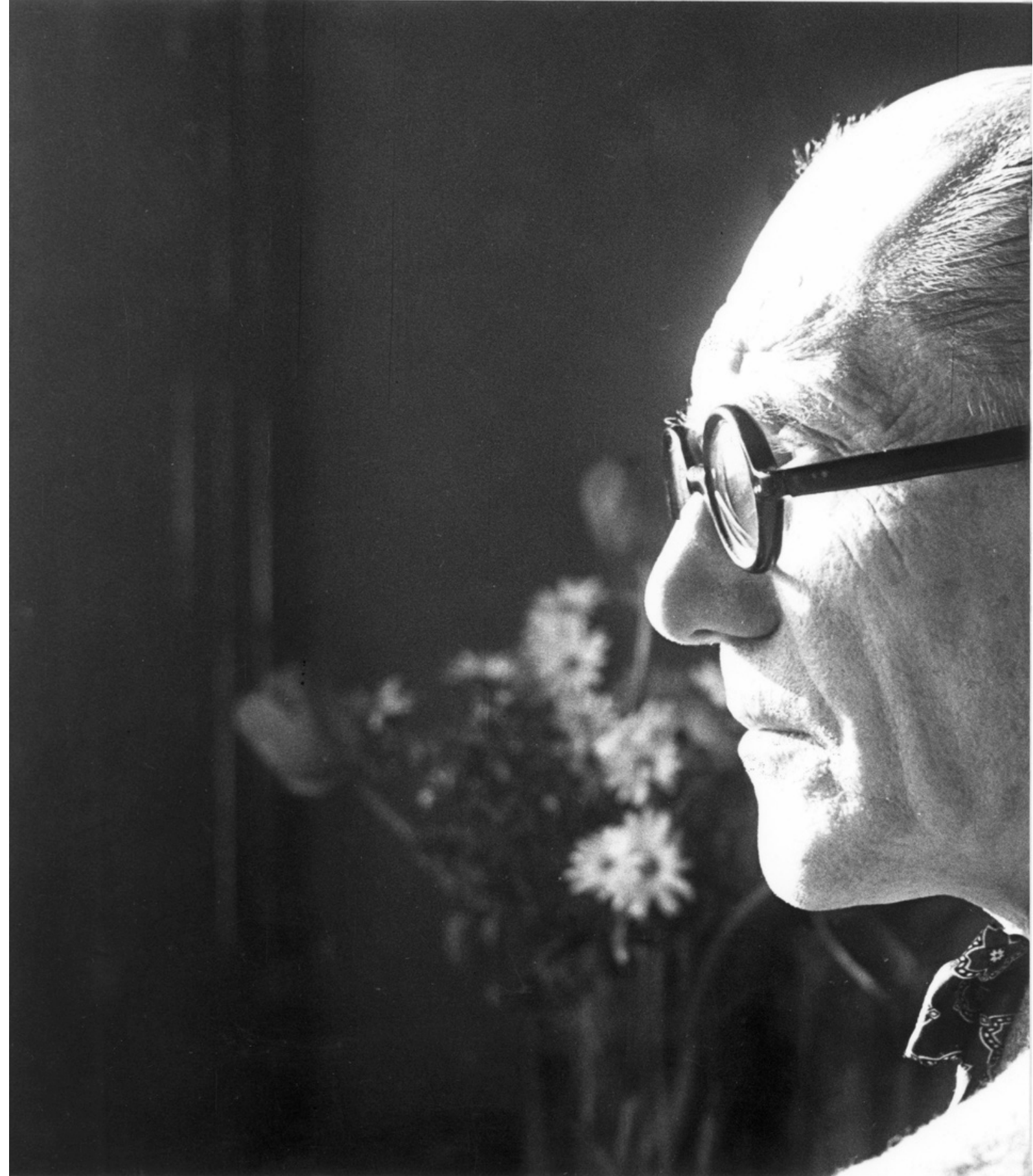

August 27, 2025 marks the 60th anniversary of Le Corbusier's death off the coast of Cabbé beach in Roquebrune-Cap-Martin. The year will therefore be dedicated to celebrating his legacy. Exhibitions (at the Maison La Roche, the Paul Klee Museum in Bern, the Panasonic Museum in Tokyo, and in Briey, Rezé, Chandigarh, and elsewhere), publications, reissues (*Towards a New Architecture*, *Urban Planning*, etc.), and events will pay tribute to his work. The summer commemorations will be followed by other events between now and the end of the year, notably at the Foundation.

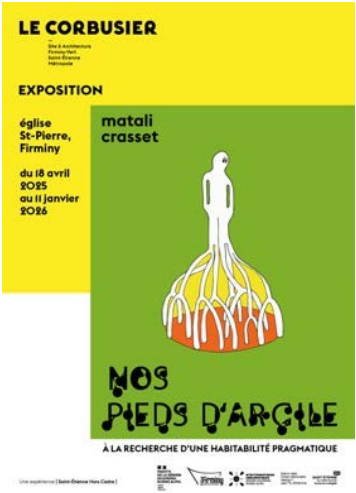
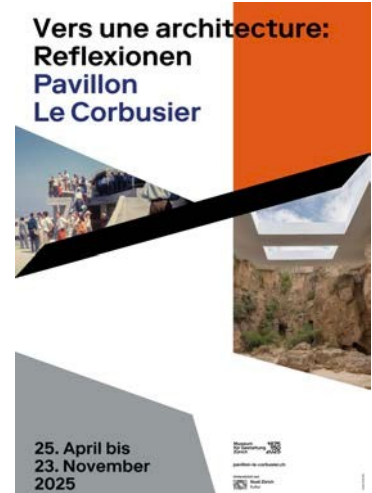
THE ORGANIC ANGLE — LILIANE TOMASKO AT THE MAISON LA ROCHE — SEPTEMBER 2 - OCTOBER 4

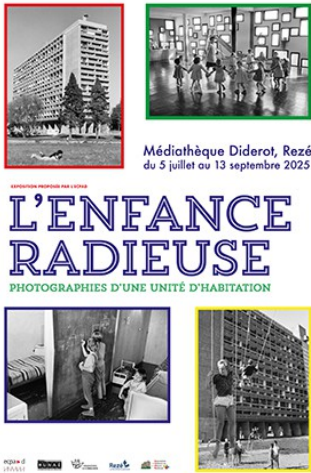
For her first solo exhibition in Paris, Liliane Tomasko presents new abstract paintings that engage in dialogue with Le Corbusier's architecture. The Maison La Roche, built between 1923 and 1925, exemplifies Le Corbusier's purist approach to housing: a space that can be experienced physically and rhythmically through circulation, color, and light. Liliane Tomasko's abstract, gestural, and lively canvases transform into pictorial topographies of the unconscious, prompting reflection on our inner states and our experience of space.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FOUNDATION

On July 9, the Foundation's Board of Directors met at the Cité Radieuse in Briey-en-Forêt.

On the sidelines of this event, the board members visited the site, private apartments, and the exhibition "Architectures et paysages" by Pierre-Louis Falocci, winner of the 2018 Grand Prix National d'Architecture, presented at the Galerie de la Première Rue (an association created in 1989 to contribute to the protection and promotion of the Unité d'habitation)..

These visits were followed by a meeting with the Association, Mayor François Dietsch and his deputy for culture, Catherine Vales, whom the Foundation commends for their commitment to preserving and promoting Le Corbusier's work to the widest possible audience.

CHINESE TOURISM PROFESSIONALS ASSOCIATION

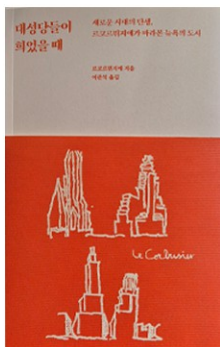
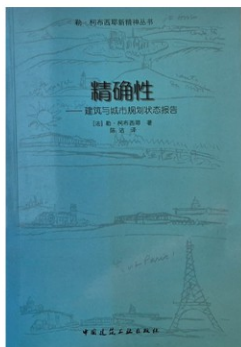
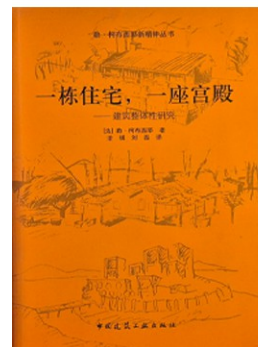

GROWING INTEREST IN LE CORBUSIER'S WORK IN ASIA

Over the past decade, there has been growing interest in Le Corbusier's work in Asia. This is reflected in numerous publications and translations of Le Corbusier's works (into Chinese, Japanese, Korean, etc.).

Symposiums, conferences on architecture, exhibitions, and lectures are also increasingly focusing on Le Corbusier, as was the case at the last Singapore Architecture Festival, to which Brigitte Bouvier, director of the Foundation, was invited.

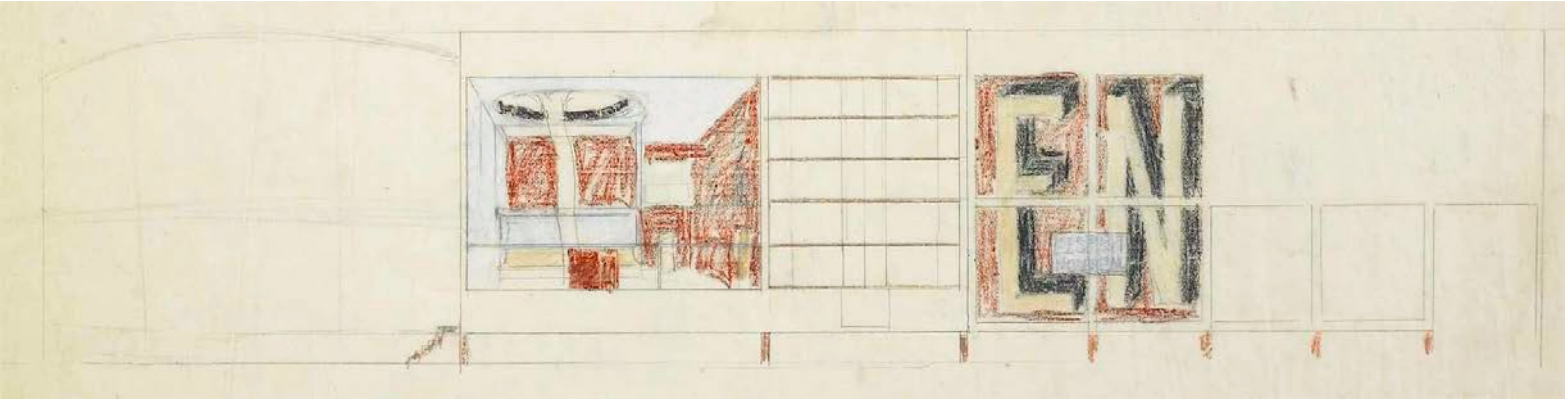


CALL FOR PAPERS

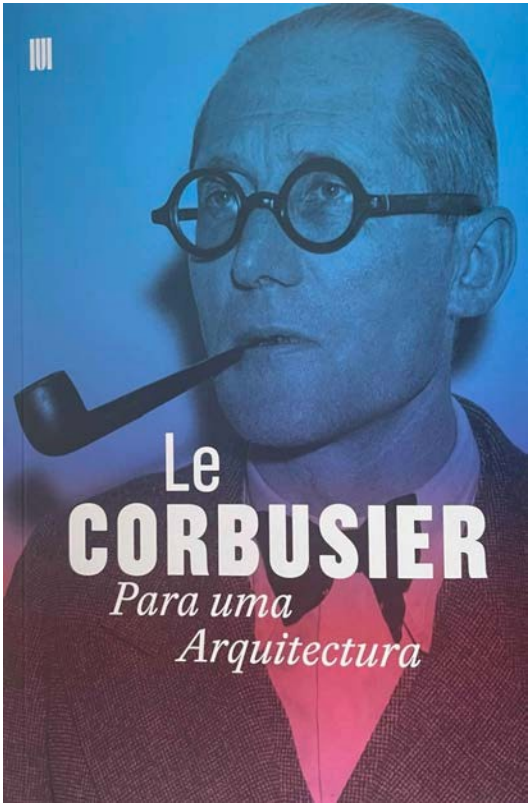
