The Le Corbusier Foundation, in collaboration with Almine Rech, presents an exhibition dedicated to Heinz Mack, an iconic figure of the ZERO movement. In the unique setting of Maison La Roche, his kinetic and op art works resonate with the purist architecture. Vibrant reliefs, luminous sculptures, and colorful paintings establish a dialogue where light becomes movement and color becomes vibration. This confrontation between Le Corbusier's iconic modernist work and Mack's experimental research reveals the power of art that questions our perception and transforms space into a sensory experience.

This bilingual Italian and English book traces the history of Sri Lankan architect Minette de Silva and her place in contemporary architecture.




MICHEL TRIBALLEAU, LE CORBUSIER, BUSINESS LEADER AND CONDUCTOR,
