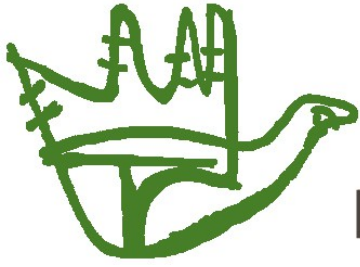

UPCOMING EXHIBITIONS

PETER DOIG — MAISON LA ROCHE — PARIS — 10 APRIL — 30 MAY

From 10 April, the Foundation will present an exhibition at Maison La Roche featuring Peter Doig, a leading figure in contemporary painting, whose works are held in major institutions such as the Tate, the Museum of Modern Art and the Centre Pompidou.

His painting draws on images from memories, photographs or films to create spaces where reality slips into the dreamlike. His landscapes – forests, expanses of water or isolated buildings – become sensitive territories, on the border between figuration and abstraction.

In the 1990s, a stay at the Unité d'Habitation in Briey, designed by Le Corbusier, shaped his relationship with architecture and the inhabited landscape. Without referring to it directly, the exhibition at Maison La Roche extends this focus on places and their power to inspire the imagination.

JUSTINO SERRALTA, L'UNITOR — KOLEKTIV CITÉ RADIEUSE - UNITÉ D'HABITATION — MARSEILLE — 3 APRIL — 25 MAY

The exhibition *Justino Serralta, l'Unitor* draws on the Uruguayan architect's archives to reconstruct – within a building designed by Le Corbusier – his time at the Atelier at 35 Rue de Sèvres between 1948 and 1950, as well as his relationship with Le Corbusier. Highlighting his work on housing units and his reflections on the Modulor with André Maissonnier, this exhibition also presents his personal reflections, his metaphysical quest and the development of *L'Unitor*.

MY HOUSE IS A LE CORBUSIER [VILLA BAIZEAU] - CRISTIAN CHIRONI — LA BOÎTE — TUNIS — TUNISIA — 3 APRIL - 17 JUNE

Launched in 2015, 'My House Is a Le Corbusier' is conceived as a residential journey. Villa Baizeau marks a new stage following stays at the Pavillon de l'Esprit Nouveau in Bologna, Le Corbusier's studio-apartment in Paris, the Unité d'habitation in Marseille, Casa Curutchet in La Plata, the Unité d'habitation in Berlin and the Maison Blanche in La Chaux-de-Fonds, represents a new stage in Cristian Chironi's project, which will continue in Antwerp, Cambridge, Tokyo, Baghdad and Moscow. Faced with the impossibility of occupying this villa, situated within the presidential park, the artist explores the concept of dwelling as a mental experience, a threshold, a distance.

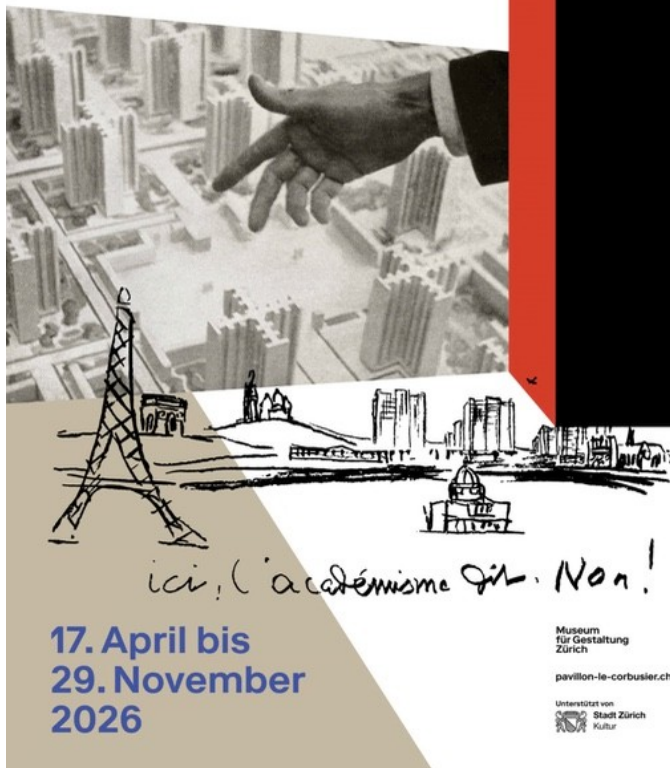
The exhibition explores the close links between architecture and power, focusing in particular on those forged between Le Corbusier and French governments, from the interwar period to the 1960s.
